They concern a good variety of subjects connected to karst and cave protection: a “depollution day” neologism used in Belgium since 1970, a 3D photos presentation, a book, a karstic space management and a field action.

The Jury of the France Habe Prize 2013 was composed by 2 members of the Scientific Committee of the UIS Department of Karst and Cave Protection and its President.

They noted each submission following an evaluation frame. They decided unanimously to attribute the France Habe Prize 2013, an amount of 250€, to the most important and more elaborated contribution at a presentation, redaction, photographic, scientific and original point of view.
